NAROOMA GOLF CLUB - NAROOMA

For golfers no visit to the south coast of NSW is complete without playing a round of Narooma's famous golf course. With a unique and stunning coastal setting the course is both a challenge for serious golfers and a pleasure to play for the not so serious.

The unique setting and overall quality of the course and greens has Narooma Golf Course favourably compared to many premiere courses around the world. Narooma has also consistently ranked highly on lists of Australia's top golf courses and has been unchallenged as the highest rated course on the NSW south coast. The Narooma Golf Club is proud to be ranked in the top 50 public courses in Australia

Narooma's most famous six holes are perched high on cliffs overlooking the Pacific Ocean - but the back nine also offers something slightly different as it heads slightly inland to feature a series of holes framed by tall timbers - before meandering around a large lake that comes into play on six of the nine holes. It is the range of varying conditions created by the ocean and forest sections of the course that are greatly appreciated by many golfers who relish the challenge of a vastly changing environment within a single round of golf.

BERMAGUI COUNTRY CLUB - BERMAGUI

Simply put, Bermagui is a beauty! And tough. Long par 4s - plenty in the 370-400 metre range - with sloping fairways and a number of blind shots to the excellent greens. Many holes have doglegs.

There are some fabulous views of the quintessential seaside town of Bermagui, Horseshoe Bay and the brooding Mount Dromedary (or Gulaga to the local Kooris). Fairways are lush and most are lined by a variety of beautiful trees. While you wouldn't say this is a heavily bunkered course, there are many strategically placed sand traps. Water features prominently on a number of holes, not least being the 164 metre, 15th, where the fairway is a lake.

Be aware that at 6,085 metres (par 72) this is a serious walk with plenty of hills. You might consider a cart. We think you will really enjoy this high quality challenging course, the beautiful views and abundant bird life.

MERIMBULA GOLF CLUB - MERIMBULA

Natural beauty abounds with bushland, wildlife and views over the Merimbula Lake which are simply dazzling. Situated between two of the Sapphire Coast's hugely popular tourist towns, Pambula-Merimbula Golf Club is a high standard, 27 hole layout. As each 9 has its individual character you can play a variety of courses and conditions, lengths and challenges, all at the one location.

The greens are large and subtle, presenting a real test of judgement for line and speed. Fairways are lush and well maintained. This is a high quality experience which will bring you back for more. The first 9 is shorter than 10-18 and 19-27 but includes some terrific holes, while the last 9 is the longest and probably the most difficult. For instance, check out the 182 metre 27th, uphill and over water. Depending on which combination is played the course varies from 5,780 metres and par 71 to 6,214 metres and par 73.

EDEN GARDENS COUNTRY CLUB - EDEN

Wow, what a surprise packet! Just north of the centre of this beautiful coastal town is a simply terrific golf course. In fact it was described recently by one golf scribe as the Augusta National of the far South Coast. This John Spencer designed, par 71, 5,706 metre layout, winds back into majestic native forest. It boasts wide, well-grassed and sometimes undulating fairways, fast challenging greens (the ball will break - don't let your nerve!), reasonably friendly sand traps and a number of water hazards.

While it's not the longest course in the area, there are plenty of doglegs which require precision hitting and careful course management. The overriding natural impression, however, is created by the many huge and magnificent trees and the prolific birdlife and other wildlife. This is well supported by the club's picturesque gardens, native wattles and waratahs.

BIG 4 WALLAGA LAKE

BIG4 Wallaga Lake Holiday Park is located on the shores of Wallaga Lake only 5km from the heart of Bermagui. Camel Rock beach is only a short walk across the road. Enjoy the amazing sunsets over the lake, watersports, bushwalking, fishing, pedal carts, canoeing and kayak hire, playground, and giant jumping pillow. Beach jetty and boat ramp make it.

Don't forget to visit the Camel Rock Brewery & Cafe a Licenced Cafe situated within BIG4 Wallaga Lake Holiday Park and housed within the historic Allowah House an original 1920's guest house renovated into the brewery and cafe with renovations completed March 2017. The menu is an American influenced menu with Burgers, Ribs, and Slow cooked and smoked meats. Salads, Subs and Cheese Platters not to mention some yummy deserts. Most importantly great on tap craft beers, commercial beers are available by the bottle, and a variety of wines and spirits.

EDEN GATEWAY HOLIDAY PARK

Eden Gateway Holiday Park is situated in the heart of beautiful Eden on the Sapphire Coast of NSW, only minutes from clubs, pubs, shops and the golf club. It offers a relaxing holiday for couples, friends and the whole family with quality accommodation and holiday park facilities that are demanded by the most astute traveller.

Enjoy the outdoor pool in the warmer months or play a round of bocce. Visit in August to late November each year and you can see Humpback Whales making their annual migration southwards along the east coast of Australia, bound for Antarctica after having spent several months in the warmer waters - some mating or giving birth.
